Royalty Guidelines

Brunswick Summer Celebration 2019 Royalty Guidelines

1. All contestants must be a resident of Medina County.
2. All contestants must be female and not currently or have never been married and/or pregnant.
3. Each title has a different set of travel requirements. These are the minimum number of events required, however travel above and beyond is encouraged. ****Divisions up to Queen do not have travel requirements**
 - **Queen:** 8 local events; 6 events less than 35 miles; 8 events less than 74 miles
 - **Queen 1st Att:** 6 local events; 4 events less than 35 miles; 7 events less than 74 miles
 - **Queen 2nd Att:** 4 local events, 2 events less than 35 miles; 3 events less than 74 miles
4. There are a few city events that are mandatory. These events will be pointed out at the newly crowned court meeting. Failure to attend these events without an acceptable excused absence could result in the loss of your title and all prizes. ****Divisions up to Little Miss may attend city events but are not mandatory.**
5. Attendance of the 2019/20 Brunswick Summer Celebration Festival is required and the dates should be taken into consideration when scheduling vacations and such. By running in the pageant and accepting the crown and sash if chosen, you are accepting the commitment to represent the City of Brunswick and the Summer Celebration Festival from the day you were crowned to the day you crown your successor.
6. It is suggested that each title holder have at least 2 formal gowns. It is suggested that you shop for these gowns at Goodwill, Salvation Army, etc. or talk to current or past court members. The girls will get these gowns dirty attending different events by walking around festival grounds or during luncheons. ****Divisions up to the Little Miss – this is not a requirement, however Easter style attire is suggested for any local events attended.**
7. Each contestant must be well groomed. All hair colors must be only natural colors, blonde; brown; black or red, etc. Hairstyles should be lady like style. All make-up should be age appropriate.

8. Ear piercings are to be kept tasteful, however gauges are not permitted at all. Any facial piercings and/or tongue piercings must be removed during pageant/festival time or while in crown/sash if crowned part of the Summer Celebration Court. Any and all tattoo's must be covered and cannot be visible. This applies to all current and/or past court members that are representing their titles under the age of 20.

9. Upon being crowned as a member of the Brunswick Summer Celebration Court, there will be a meeting to welcome title holders and parents held after festival tear down and this must be attended by all court members and at least one parent and/or legal guardian. The location and time will be determined and provided after the conclusion of the festival on Sunday evening and the information will be presented to the newly crowned court at that time. Important information will be passed along and upcoming festivals will be gone over, therefore attendance is required. At that time, the Royalty/Parent Contract will be handed out for review and signatures. ***Divisions up to the Little Miss – a short parent meeting will be held immediately following crowning on the night of their pageant.*

10. All correspondence within the court from the Queens Directors/Committee will be done via email, which also includes upcoming festival notifications. If you do not have an email account, it is encouraged that a gmail or yahoo account is set up. It is also encouraged during the busy travel season that this email is checked frequently as to not miss any important information or deadlines.

11. There is a financial expectation for travel. Each festival luncheon attended customarily costs approximately \$10 - \$15 (possibly \$20 at a select few luncheons) and will be the responsibility of the family of each title holder attending. ***N/A for Divisions up to the Queen*

12. **Each pageant contestant will be required to pay a registration fee. Little Miss contestants \$25.00; Jr Miss contestants \$35.00 and Queen contestants \$45.00. Referral discount may be applied for any new contestant running on the recommendation of a current pageant participant. ****Divisions up to the Little Miss, the registration fee is \$25. ***Early registration discount available until May 31, 2019*****

13. Prizes are as follows to be given at the successful end of your reign:
 - a. Queen - \$500 cash award, crown/sash
 - b. Queen Att - \$350 cash award, crown/sash
 - c. Queen Att - \$200 cash award, crown/sash
 - i. Divisions up to the Queen do not receive any monetary award, however, they will receive a crown, sash and trophy
